HOME CLEANING CASTILE SOAP

1

Make a versatile general purpose spray cleaner (think benches, tables, highchairs, glass and damp dusting etc). Dilute 5ml soap into 500ml water. Add 6-10 drops of essential oil for scent.

2

For bathrooms and heavier soiling, dilute 10ml in 500ml water. Spray, then let grime dissolve for a few minutes before wiping clean.

3

Cleaning the loo. Use 2.5-5ml neat directly into the bowl, scrub and flush. Outside the loo can be cleaned with the general purpose spray cleaner.

4

Dishes by hand. Use 10ml in half a sink of hot water. For roast pans after scraping out the bulk of the fat, use 10ml neat directly onto the fat, scrub to emulsify the fat, then rinse with hot water.

5

For general cleaning, mopping floors and hand laundry use 15-30ml in a bucket of water. Hot water for floors, warm water for delicate clothing.

6

Spot cleaning carpet, sofa and hard surfaces. Use a small amount of soap undiluted on a damp cloth, rinse well.

7

Make foaming hand soap. To your foaming soap dispenser add 10-30% soap then top up with water (more soap makes thicker foam). Add 6-10 drops essential oils of your choosing
